

**SULLIVAN CONSERVATION COMMISSION**  
**Sullivan Town Hall**  
**Jan. 8, 2020**

**Present:** Wendy Byrn, Wendy Pelletier, Eric White, Chip Woodbury and Becky Cummings.

The minutes of the November meeting were accepted as read. Motion by Chip; seconded by Eric – all in favor. There was no meeting in December.

Wendy received a contract from Keene Recycling with a projected amount for hazardous waste collection in 2020. It is payable after town meeting in March. Eric said he believes this is the first time the town has received a contract.

Two “Intents to Cut” have been filed since the last conservation meeting. One is for John Ouellette on Gilsum Rd. for 150 cords to be taken off 48 acres. Dale Paquette will do the work. The other is for Therese Hotchkiss on Cross Rd. for 50 cords to be taken from 96 acres. Tim Sargent will do the work.

Wendy asked that members of the commission each choose a topic for presentation at the proposed Saturday Conservation Talks. Roger has already spoken with Bob Switzer, who has agreed to talk about their solar power. That talk is tentatively scheduled for Feb. 22 at the library. Nelson has an agricultural lecture on the 29<sup>th</sup>, so that date was avoided. Commission members were also encouraged to think of a “catchy” name for the Saturday get-togethers.

Wendy P. made a motion to adjourn the meeting; Chip seconded and all in favor. Meeting adjourned at 7:27pm.
