The minutes of the July meeting (postponed to Aug. 3) were approved as written. Motion made by Chip; Roger seconded and all in favor.

Some Conservation members recently attended the site inspections of two driveway permit applications.

Ahlberg – on Centre St. across from Amazing Grace Animal Sanctuary (161 Centre). Sullivan was there in an advisory capacity only. The final decision is that of the State since it is on a state road. The driveway will be 15' wide; aprons are not required for the state as they are for the town.

Dogopoulos – across from 488 South Rd. (Chip Woodbury's). The driveway application seemed to be in order, but Roger & Chip have concerns about the location of the house and width of the lot at that point.

Wendy B. said things are proceeding well with the Button Up program on Oct. 6 at 6:30 pm. Ads will be posted soon and it will be in the newsletter. Robbin at Button Up will contact the Shopper and Sentinel. We will discuss refreshments at the next meeting. Paul Bolduc will set up the zoom portion of it.

The Piper Memorial Walk/Hike with a bit of history with Chris Pratt is set for Oct. 1 at 2 pm.

A hearing for a special exception was held for Del Ouellette to operate an auto repair business on Valley Rd. It was approved with several conditions. Future hearings are scheduled for Perra on Gilsum Rd. for a child care facility and Kirkpatrick for a building site in the Bolles subdivision.
