The minutes of the July meeting were accepted as read.

Chip pointed out that the information concerning land use and conservation begins on page 41 of the current Master Plan. He recommends members take a little time to read it over and perhaps think of suggestions we might like to make to the Planning Board. It can be found on the Town of Sullivan website under "Ordinances and Forms".

Chip said he had walked much of the Piper Forest logging job with Brad Smith, the land steward. The logging company contracted by The Society for Protection of N H Forests has done an excellent job; local logger, Mark Smith also agrees. There was a question of what the pink flags might be for. Brad plans to contact The Society to see if they know.

Chip spoke with Dave Dauphin in Gilsum about local combined town hikes. Dave is on the Gilsum trail committee, but suggested Chip speak with the local librarian who is in charge of local hikes.

Wendy Byrn was not able to attend tonight's meeting but sent out important information on solar power in NH to all members.
