Wendy P. called the meeting to order at 6:37pm.

The minutes of the Oct. meeting were accepted as read – Chip (motion), Becky (seconded), all in favor.

Laurie Goldsmith was welcomed to the Conservation Commission and introduced to the members.

Wendy P. read a note of resignation to the Commission from Roger Sweet. It was accepted with regret. To honor both Roger and Ann, Wendy P. suggested removing the euonymus (burning bush) in front of the town hall, an invasive shrub and “thorn” in Roger’s side, and replacing it with something of his choosing. Members agreed this is a good idea.

We will be serving food again – makings for sandwiches, chili and misc. dessert type foods. Laurie will make a meat chili and Wendy a vegetable chili.
