The minutes of the June meeting were accepted as read.

Wendy P. has not had a chance to ask Milton about a birding walk yet, but will get to it soon.

Mark Smith, the logger who is doing the tree work in Jewett Park, finally submitted his signed contract and certificate of insurance to the town.

Chip asked if everything went well on the driveway permit meeting – Valley Road near Sherpa's. Wendy P. explained that at this time it will be only for access only, not for a residence. There were no problems.

Wendy P. mentioned that Chip Chapman, Gilsum Conservation, suggested a combined Gilsum/Sullivan hike somewhere. Consideration will be given to Calhoun Family Forest, Porcupine Falls and Bear Dens Park & Trail.

Chip dug out all the remainder of the burning bush in front of the town hall that he could, but said there will be roots in there for some time.

Discussion followed on what the commission might sponsor for interested talks this fall or winter. Invasive species were mentioned. Wendy B. will check with the county forester and/or UNH Extension to see if they may be able to recommend any speakers.

Becky moved to adjourn, Chip seconded and all agreed to adjourn the meeting at 7:12 pm.
