Present: Wendy Pelletier, Roger Sweet, Chip Woodbury and Becky Cummings.

The minutes of the May meeting were approved as read. Motion to accept by Wendy P., seconded Roger – all in favor.

Wendy B., who is working on the Button Up Program, but not able to attend tonight's meeting, asked the commission to pick two or three dates they thought would be good for the program. After a short discussion, the group was in agreement that fall was a better choice than summer and chose Sept. 22 & 29 and Oct. 6.

Liz Newcomb's driveway on South Rd. was approved, although there are some drainage concerns. This is part of the Bolles subdivision.

Becky said there are 6 copies of the NRI left. They are in one of the file cabinets labeled Conservation in the town clerk's filing room.

It has been brought to our attention a campground has opened at Chapman Pond on the Wheeler property, Chapman Pond Acres. It is not large, 2 to 4 tents or 1 RV, but concerns were brought up wondering if there are state regulations or permits that should be followed, especially since it is waterfront.
