

SULLIVAN CONSERVATION COMMISSION
Sullivan Town Hall
March 22, 2023

Present: Laurie Goldsmith, Wendy Pelletier, Chip Woodbury and Becky Cummings.

Wendy called the meeting to order at 6:35pm. Chip made a motion to accept the minutes of the February meeting, Laurie seconded, all approved.

A brief discussion of HB 2 (revise or remove the professional licensure and certification (OPLC) of several of the state's occupations) followed. Members were familiar with it as Wendy B. had circulated information from the NHACC. Becky made a motion to join with NHACC and other commissions in the state in opposition to HB2. Chip seconded. Vote to sign on to the NHACC's letter in support of NH Natural Scientists and opposition to HB2 was unanimous.

Earth Day/Roadside Cleanup – Wendy B. will be in contact with Laurie G. to set up a library display. Poster making is still scheduled for Apr. 15 in the church. Cleanup day food will be as in years past – makings for sandwiches,

No decision has been made on the location of Scott Wood's well on his 16 acres on Cross Rd. The question came up of why he wanted to put the well behind his house, near the property line when the property is so large and afforded many other sites for it.

Wendy P. has received the NHACC Handbook. For the time being, it will be kept in the Cardinal Surveying office, if anyone would like to borrow it.

Wendy P. and Gaynelle Pratt are attending the NH Housing Academy Brad Smith will attend on an alternative date.

Becky mentioned that in the spring, the trail to Meetinghouse Rock often needs work from winter blow-down, etc. Chip said he would will take a walk up there to access the situation when the snow melts. We also need to check out the kiosk and see if there are maps of Sullivan trails available.

A few people in town wondered about the "campground" at Chapman Pond. Do they need or possibly already have approval from the town or state? It has also been brought to our attention that motor vehicles are being stored at the old Ouellette junkyard property. Does this have a permit? Do these two need to go through site plan reviews?

Chip made a motion to adjourn; Becky seconded. Meeting adjourned at 7:25 pm.
