Eric and Jim have removed the tree stand on the Town Farm. If the owner wants to claim it, it is in the basement storage area of the town hall.

Wendy has still not received a bid from Chris Lane about Jewett Park work. She will contact Under the Sun.

The selectmen received Intents to Cut from Richard Hotchkiss and Milton Trimitsis.

The Town received notification from DES (Dept. of Environmental Services) that work around the cell tower on Apple Hill still does not conform to requirements that had been established. The construction company/landowner has been given 30 days to comply.

There is still an outstanding request on the David Swett property to correct unpermitted wetlands impacts associated with logging. He was previously given a cease & desist order until such work is complete.

Trail work in town is tentatively scheduled for May 18. Wendy will contact Eric for a list of the trails people and get an email reminder sent out.
