Since Wendy P. left the commission for the Planning Board, we need a new chairman. Chip suggested perhaps co-chairmen. Laurie is not interested at this time. Becky will remain clerk.

Becky opened a large laminated poster of NH wildflowers that was found at the recent church Memorial Day Yard Sale. It is a good size for the kiosk at the foot of Winch Hill. Chip will put it up and also put some new maps in the box at the kiosk. At one time a set of land use regulations for Winch Hill/Town Farm had been drawn up between the Town Trustees and Conservation. Becky wondered if the Trustees might have a copy. It might be good to post those, too.

The Sullivan Library is planning a hike/walk to Meetinghouse Rock on July 27 as part of their Adventure Begins at Your Library reading program this summer. Chip said he will check out the trail and see how much work it needs. Chris Pratt, town archivist, will be along to tell a bit of the history of the area, too.

Chip said 23 people participated in town clean-up this year. Todd took 400 pounds of trash to the recycling center. This is less than previous years.

Note was made of a Cheshire County Conservation District birding event at Milton's 5 Sigma Farm on June 7.
