

**SULLIVAN CONSERVATION COMMISSION**  
**Sullivan Town Hall**  
**Nov. 13, 2019**

**Present:** Wendy Byrn, Wendy Pelletier, Roger Sweet, Chip Woodbury and Becky Cummings.

Roger made a motion to accept the October 2019 minutes as written; Chip seconded and all voted in favor.

Wendy P. said she presented her budget to the budget committee and it went well. There was no provision made for educational presentations (including refreshments for same) in the budget, so Wendy said she would request an additional \$100 for them at the Budget Hearing. Those in attendance agreed it is a good idea.

Wendy B. has been in touch with NH Saves/Buttun Up about doing a workshop in town. She will check to see if they do weekend afternoons as well as evenings and also when someone (probably Ted Stiles) would be available in the coming months. This is part of the Eversource program to help people save energy in their homes and includes thermal imaging (waiting list). Wendy P. had her house done 5 years ago and she has seen a big difference in that her house is much warmer and the fuel bills are lower!

Wendy P. attended the planning board's review for a proposed driveway for Scott & Val Wood on Cross Rd. Phil Hamilton will be the contractor. The proposed driveway was moved a few feet to avoid a culvert, but aside from that, it was approved as applied for.

Becky mentioned the Crayola recycling program, ColorCycle, that recycles and converts old markers into energy as well as wax compounds for asphalt and roofing shingles. The commission will check to see if this is something the school is doing already or if it is something they might be interested in doing with the commission.

Roger mentioned that Eversource has an incentive program for old refrigerators that are still running. This includes free haul-away, savings of up to \$150 per year in energy costs by not running the old appliance and a \$30 incentive check from the electric utility for participation. The committee should look into this. He will also check with Bob Switzer and Paul Bolduc to see if they might be interested in speaking about the energy saving things they have done around their own homes.

No meeting will be held in December. When members find out more about the programs they have in mind, emails will be sent out to other members; possible dates set up for presentation(s) and information for the newsletter.

Becky made a motion to adjourn at 7:15; Chip seconded and all in favor. Meeting adjourned!
