The State Board of Education finds the Monadnock Regional Cooperative School District at the special district meeting on October 23, 2012, approved the plan for the withdrawal of Sullivan from Monadnock Regional Cooperative School District.

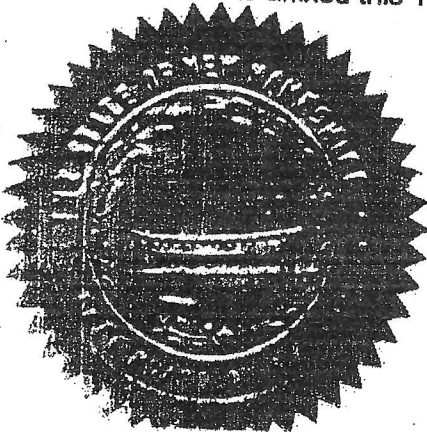
The State Board of Education finds the Sullivan withdrawal plan from Monadnock Regional Cooperative School District was offered in compliance with the New Hampshire Laws RSA 195:25-29 and was adopted by a majority of the voters present and voting in the district on November 27, 2012.

Now Therefore:

The State Board of Education does hereby issue its certificate to such effect.

The State Board of Education does further certify the continuation of the Monadnock Regional Cooperative School District to include the school districts of Fitzwilliam, Gilsum, Richmond, Roxbury, Swanzey and Troy. It is lawfully adopted with all the powers, rights and privileges and subject to all limitations, duties and restrictions, which by law appertain thereto.

The legal voters of the re-established school district of Sullivan, New Hampshire are hereby notified and warned that a special meeting of the voters will take place on Tuesday, January 8, 2013 at the Sullivan Town Hall in Sullivan, New Hampshire at 7:00 p.m. to act on the following articles:


Article 1. To see if the District will vote pursuant to RSA 194-C:2 to create a planning committee to study whether the Sullivan School District should withdraw from School Administrative Unit 93.

Article 2. To take any other action that may lawfully come before the meeting.

NOTE: The business meeting of the re-established Sullivan School District including the election of officers will take place in March 2013 at a date, time and place to be determined.
